OPEN BURN ORDINANCE

**The City of New Auburn allows for open burning of dried organic matter from
September 15th through December 1st. We do ask at any other time of the year you
take your dried organic matter to the burn pile. Only City Employees are allowed to
burn at the City burn pile. Recreational fires are allowed at any time of the year as
long as they are 3 feet in diameter by 3 feet high and only dried matter. Any
questions, please read ordinance 90.1.**
