

ORDINANCE NUMBER 103d
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 103
BUILDING AND LAND USE REGULATION
AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 103 TO OPTING-OUT OF THE
REQUIREMENTS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. #462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family and health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. #462.3593 allows cities to "opt out" of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW AUBURN, ORDAINS as follows:

902.05 subdivision 12 is amended as follows:


901.02 General Requirements.

Subdivision 12 Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of New Auburn opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. #462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication.
