ORDINANCE NO. 400B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF NEW AUBURN MUNICIPAL CODE, NUMBER 400, REGULATING PARKING OF VEHICLES AND OTHER OBJECTS ON THE STREETS AND REGULATING TRUCK ROUTES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEW AUBURN

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW AUBURN ORDAINS:

Section 7. Penalties, Subdivision 1. of Ordinance No. 400 currently reads as follows:

Subdivision 1. Violation of this ordinance shall be considered a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be punished by the maximum penalty allowed by Minnesota law for a misdemeanor.

Section 7. Penalties, Subdivision 1. of Ordinance No. 400 shall be amended to read:

Subdivision 1. Any violation of this section shall be a petty misdemeanor unless it is committed in a manner and under a circumstance so as to endanger any person or property, and then in that event, it shall be a misdemeanor. The punishment shall be in conformance with the Statutes and payable amounts as set by the State of Minnesota.

This amended ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication according to law.
